

Inmate Classification for Detention Staff

This course is open to all sworn or non-sworn Detention Center staff, medical first responders, or related public service agency personnel.

Presented through a combination of classroom lecture and practical exercises, this 2-hour course will provide students with materials that will help them understand the importance of inmate classification and current legal requirements. Legal duties regarding inmate classification will be discussed with an emphasis on a layered approach to oversight to ensure proper placement for safety and security. Topics covered will include:

Constitutional Law	8th Amendment concerns
Farmer vs Brennan	Deliberate Indifference
Martin vs Alameda County	Sheriff's office requirements
Deputy applications	Civil Liability
