

## **Inmate Rights & Privileges for Professional/Commissioned Staff**

This course is open to all sworn or non-sworn Detention Center staff, medical first responders, or related public service agency personnel.

Presented through a combination of classroom lecture and practical exercises, this 2-hour course will provide students with materials that will help them understand the importance of inmate rights and understanding of those that remain while incarcerated. Legal requirements regarding inmate rights will be discussed with an emphasis on the 1<sup>st</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup>, 6<sup>th</sup>, 8<sup>th</sup>, and 14<sup>th</sup> Amendments. Topics covered will include:

Constitutional Law
Search and Seizure
Religious requirements
Deputy applications
Freedoms ensured/retained
Rights guaranteed/punishments
Rights regarding facilities
Civil Liability
